A flu vaccine is recommended for everyone over 6 months of age.

The CDC (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention) states that the following people are at a higher risk of serious flu complications or spreading the flu and should make sure to get a flu shot every year.

- Persons 65 years of age and older
- Children ages 6 months—4 yrs old (59 months)
- Those who live in a long-term care facility
- Persons with chronic medical conditions
- Women who will be pregnant during the flu season
- American Indians/Alaska Natives
- Health care staff who work directly with patients
- Family members and caregivers of children under 5 years old or adults over age 65
- People who live with or care for adults with chronic medical conditions.

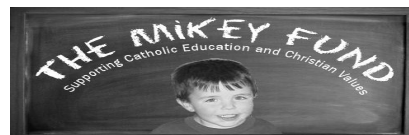
