Onondaga County provides Free cancer screenings for men and women without health insurance. Screenings are done in private doctor offices. For more information, call 435-3653.

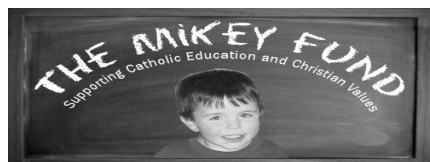


Youth Group News

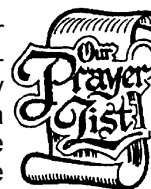

Please join us for food, fun, and music for a good cause...the ability to walk without limitations! A fundraiser to help Parker Wall. Parker was diagnosed with Cerebral Palsy at the age of 1 and can only walk with the aid of a walker. The muscle tone in his legs is so constricting that he is not even able to keep his heels down while walking.

There is a surgical procedure called Selective Dorsal Rhizotomy that will hopefully give him the ability to walk on his own in 6-12 months.
