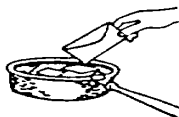
The Small World Nursery: There will be no Nursery during the 10:30 Mass until September 19th. We look forward to seeing all the children in September.

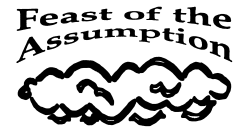

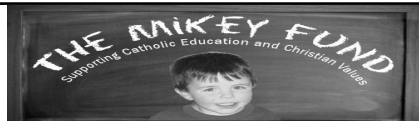
